PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

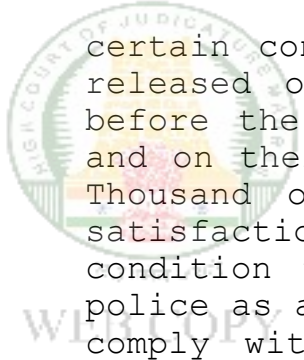
The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 323, 324, 341, 506(i) and 109 IPC and r/w Section 4 of TNPWH Act, in Crime No.164 of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the second petitioner's daughter was abused by the defacto complainant's side and thereafter a case was registered against them and thereafter, the petitioners attacked the defacto complainant and abused with filthy words and threatened the defacto complainant with dire consequences. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners.

4.The learned Additional Public Government submitted that the injured persons have been discharged from the hospital.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with



certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Court No.I, Ramanathapuram and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
