PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No.100 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that when the defacto complainant was talking with his friends in the school campus, the petitioner herein / A1 and his friends abused the defacto complainant and attacked him with knife and billhook and threatened the defacto complainant with dire consequences. Due to which the defacto complainant sustained injuries and has taken treatment in the hospital as inpatient. Hence a case has been registered.

3.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) submitted that the defacto complainant has been discharged from the hospital.



5. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.2, Virudhunagar, Virudhunagar District, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
