PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

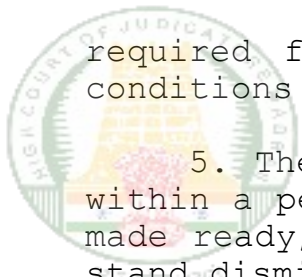
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as Accused No.4, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 408, 477(A), 465, 468, 471, 420 and 506 (ii) IPC r/w Section 34 IPC in Crime No.21 of 2018, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the State.

3. This Court had dismissed the earlier petition on 27.07.2018. Thereafter, the first accused was granted bail on condition that he should pay a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- by the learned Judicial Magistrate. The petitioner herein is the wife of the first accused.

4.Taking into consideration of change in circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Trichy, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when



required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy is made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
