PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

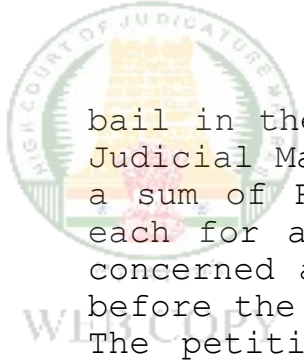
The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(ii) of I.P.C and Section 4 of Women Harassment Act in Crime No.215 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner was love in affair with the de-facto complainant's daughter Jancy. Thereafter, he arranged the marriage of some other girl with the petitioner and the same was questioned by the de-facto complainant and his wife. Therefore, the petitioner and other accused attacked and threatened the de-facto complainant in filthy language. Hence, the complaint.

3. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the injured has been discharged from the hospital.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on



bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court, Sivagiri, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
