5.The learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondent Nos.1 to 4, on instructions, would submit that the petitioner's Service Register Book, which is sent by the fifth respondent School, is pending before the third respondent, for getting approval. He would further submit that it will be considered within the time stipulated by this Court.

6.In view of the submission made by the learned Special Government Pleader, this Court directs the third respondent to approve the petitioner's Service Register Book, which is sent by the fifth respondent School, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

7.With the above direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
