2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) for the respondent.

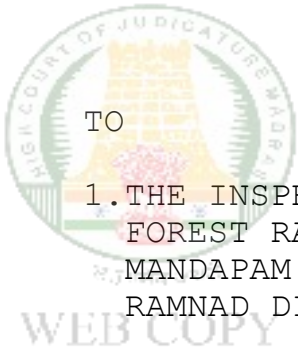
3.This Court had rejected the petitioner's earlier applications on the ground that he is having bad antecedents. Now there is no change of circumstances.
