PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec. 439 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner is in judicial custody since 09.08.2018 for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 353, 307 and 506(ii) I.P.C in Crime No.392 of 2018 on the file of the respondent police. He seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 02.07.2018, the petitioner went to the defacto complainant's bar and assaulted him with aruval. When the respondent police went to secure the petitioner, at that time, the petitioner scolded the respondent police with filthy language and also tried to attack him. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent. He did not commit any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioner is in incarceration from 09.08.2018 onwards. Hence, he prays for bail.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent would submit that the petitioner is having six previous cases and the investigation is pending.



5. Considering the above facts and circumstances and also considering the period of incarceration of the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to the following conditions:

(i) the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Kovilpatti.

(ii) the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily twice i.e morning at 10.30 a.m. and evening at 5.30 p.m until further orders;
