It is made clear that the Revenue Divisional Officer, Tiruchendur shall give opportunity to all the parties concerned and take an appropriate decision in the interest of all the parties concerned.

5. With the above direction, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is also closed.
