ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

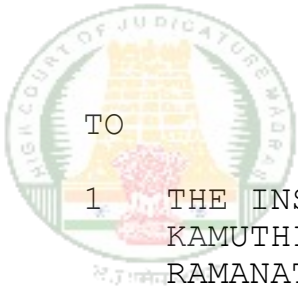
