ORDER

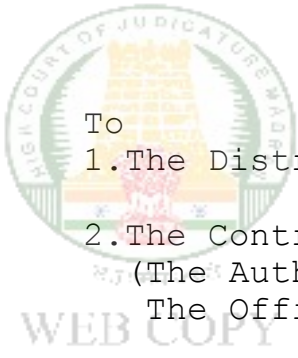
