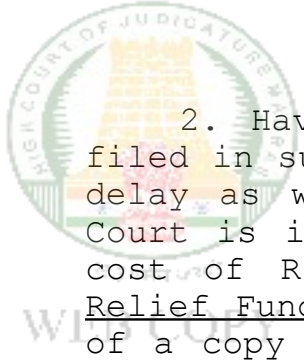

To set aside the Judgment and decree passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal cum Additional District & Sessions Judge, Theni at Periyakulam, made in M.C.O.P.No.44/2016 dated 22.09.2017 and allow this appeal.

ORDER : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.R.RAJAMANI, Advocate for the petitioner and of Mrs.J.BALAMEENAKSHI, on behalf of the Respondents 1 to 3, the court made the following order:-
