ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under Section 379 I.P.C., in Crime No.140 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and other accused had illegally transported the river sand by using Tractor bearing Reg.No.TN-49-2998. Hence, a case has been registered.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

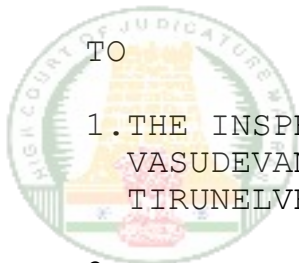
