COMMON ORDER

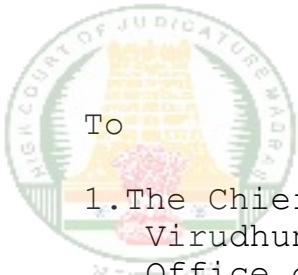
