PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 417 and 506(i) of I.P.C. in Crime No.3 of 2018, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the de-facto complainant alleged to have preferred a complaint against the petitioners alleging that the petitioners are behind the stoppage of his daughter's marriage to be held on 12.09.2018. Since the bridegroom is the brother of this petitioner. The bridegroom is not interested in the marriage and hence the marriage was stopped.

3. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent would submit that the investigation is pending.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Additional Madurai Court, (Judicial Magistrate Level), Madurai, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand



only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

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6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
