PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

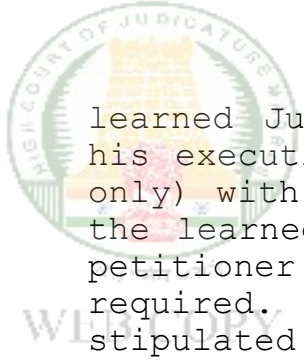
The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 447, 427 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., r/w 3(1) of TNPPDL Act in Cr.No.300 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 13.09.2018, the accused persons trespassed into the defacto complainant's shopping complex, break opened those shops and stolen the good and on questioning the same, the accused persons abused him with filthy languages and threatened him with dire consequences.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent police submitted that investigation is pending.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the



learned Judicial Magistrate, Kodaikanal, Dindigul District and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
