PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 294(b), 436 and 506(i) I.P.C. in Crime No.159 of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 01.09.2018, the petitioners and other accused persons abused the defacto complainant in filthy language and caused fire to the defacto complainant's shop by using petrol. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that the petitioners caused fire to the defacto complainant's shop, worth about Rs.1,000/- and the investigation is pending.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. The petitioners are jointly directed to deposit a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only) to the credit of Crime No.159 of 2018 before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Kuzhithurai. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in



the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Kuzhithurai and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

6.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
