PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 342, 323, 506 (i) of IPC and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Woman Act, 498(A), 406 and 506(i) of IPC in Crime No.131 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant has vacant plot opposite of his house and the same was claimed by the petitioner's family members, in this regard there was a dispute between the defacto complainant's family and the petitioners' family, while being so the one Subramani who is the accused No.1 tried to erect stone in the said land it was questioned by the defacto complainant, immediately said Subramani and the petitioners assaulted the defacto complainant and his wife.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent submitted that the injured has been discharged from the hospital.



5. Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvadanai, Ramanathapuram District and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
