PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

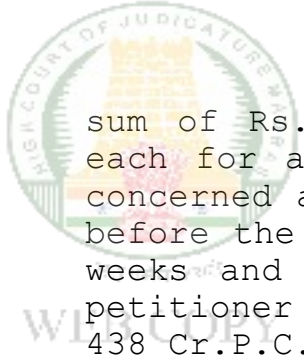
The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Section 5 r/w Section 7(3) of Tamil Nadu Lotteries Regulation Act, 1998 in Crime No.184 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 22.09.2018, the petitioner and accused nos. 1 to 4 were committed an offence of sale of prohibited lottery tickets. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent submitted that based on the confession statement of Accused Nos. 1 to 4, this petitioner has been implicated. The petitioner was only selling the said lottery tickets. He further submitted that the investigation is pending and all the lottery tickets were recovered.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.V, Trichy and on his executing a bond for a



sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
