PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

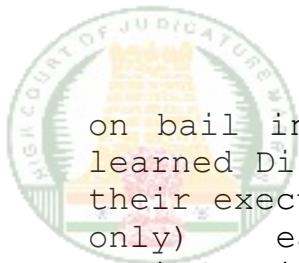
The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323 and 506(i) of I.P.C. in crime No.128 of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners trespassed the complainant's land and started the cultivation work through tractor and there was a quarrel between the defacto complainant and the petitioners and at that time, the petitioners 1 and 2 were assaulted the complainant with stick and the petitioners 3 and 4 were assaulted the complainant's wife with hand and threatened the complainant's life. Hence, the complaint,.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners.

4.The learned Government Advocate (criminal side) submitted that the injured has been discharged from the hospital.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released



on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvadanai and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
