ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 379, 353 and 430 IPC, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.This Court had dismissed his earlier petition for anticipatory bail.
