PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

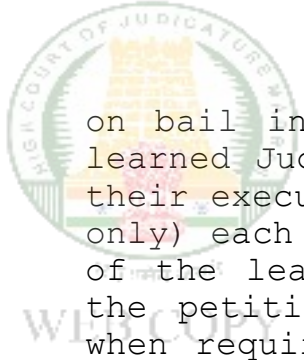
The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under Sections 498(A), 294(b) and 354 of I.P.C in Crime No.18 of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the de-facto complainant is second wife of the first petitioner and the first petitioner is second husband of the de-facto complainant. The de-facto complainant married the first petitioner on 01.12.2014, due to matrimonial dispute between them, the petitioners scolded the de-facto complainant and abused her with filthy language. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) submitted that the no previous case is pending against the petitioners.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released



on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Additional Mahila Court, Trichy and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
