COMMON ORDER

The plaintiffs in O.S.No.298 of 2015 on the file of the District Munsif Court, Thanjavur, are the revision petitioners herein. It is a suit for bare injunction. After the evidence was concluded on either side, the matter was posed for arguments. The plaintiffs filed three Interlocutory Applications. One for reopen, second one for recall and the third one for marking new documents.
