ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 8(c) r/w 20(b)(ii) (c) and 25 of NDPS Act, in Crime No.79 of 2017, seeks anticipatory bail.
