PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

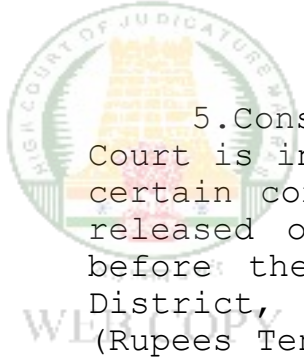
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 323, 324, 506(ii) and 307 IPC and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, 2002 and Section 3 of TNPPDL Act, in Crime No.84 of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners should not be accepted the defacto complainant to do take bath in the pond and then they had stopped him and fighting each other and hence, caused injury to the defacto complainant. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the injured person has been discharged from the hospital.



5.Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thiruppattur, Sivagangai District, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
