PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 307, 323, 324, 332, 506(ii) I.P.C in Crime No.45 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that when the defacto complainant and two others executing warrant against the petitioner's son, at that time, the petitioner along with others attacked the defacto complainant and also abused with filthy language. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent. On the date of occurrence, the petitioner made question with the defacto complainant with regard to the warrant to his son. At that time, the defacto complainant fell down and got injury by himself only. Hence, he prays for anticipatory.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent submitted that the injured has been discharged from the hospital.



5. Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Vilathikulam, Thoothukudi District and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
