Prayer in CMA(MD) No.SR 10592 of 2018:-

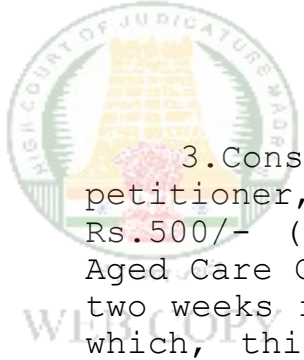
