PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

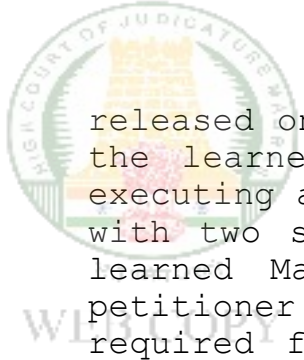
The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 143, 188 and 289 IPC r/w Section 24 of Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960, in Crime No.132 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 26.09.2018, the petitioner and other villagers were conducting Jallikattu on the eve of Arulmigu Sri Alaguputhira Ayyanar Temple festival without getting any permission from any authority. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the defacto complainant. Therefore, he seeks anticipatory bail.

4.Heard the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the State.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be



released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Ramanathapuram, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
