PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

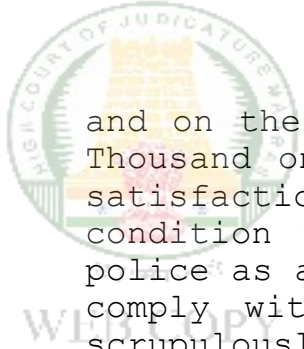
The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 323, 365 & 506(ii) I.P.C in Crime No.469 of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant is a Document Writer and he has wrote the document belongs to Accused No.1. With respect to execution of document, there was dispute arose. At that time the petitioners and some other persons were came to the place of the Sub Registrar Office, Srivilliputhur and pulled the defacto complainant. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that no one sustained injury in this case.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Srivilliputhur, Virudhunagar District



and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
