PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

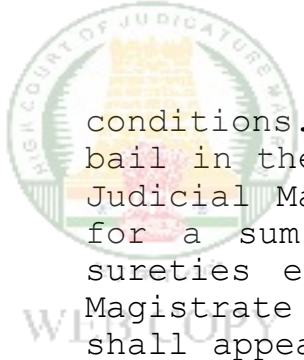
The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 174 (3) Cr.P.C @ 306 of IPC, in Crime No.181 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the marriage between the deceased and the petitioner took place on 30.10.2017. The petitioner was working in abroad and the deceased was working as nurse in Coimbatore. Whiles, the petitioner asked his wife to resign her job and live along with his parents. Thereafter she committed suicide on 17.08.2018 by hanging herself. Hence the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner was working in abroad at that time and through phone he asked the deceased to resign her job and live with his parents. Except this allegations, no other instigation were made by the petitioner to commit suicide.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent submitted that the petitioner committed suicide by hanging herself.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain



conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Kovilpatti and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
