PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 399 I.P.C, in Crime No.223 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 07.10.2018, the Inspector of Police along others both are working as a Special Sub Inspector of Police in the respondent police station, while at the time of police patrol, the petitioner and 9 others were sitting in the Pudukottai Ulur Sellikuruchi lake Northeren side and planning to the dacoity the Vandipettai Petrol bunk at night time. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) for the respondent.

4.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Pattukottai, Thanjavur District and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30.am., until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.



5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
