PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 6(4) of TNSC (RDCS) Order 1982 r/w 7(i) (a)(ii) of EC Act 1955, in Crime No.171 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner illegally purchased the PDS rice to the tune of 400 kg and kept in a hidden place. Hence, a case has been registered.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent.

4.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. The petitioner is directed to contribute 50 kgs of rice to Anbagam, Race Course Road, K.Pudur, Madurai 600 007. On receipt of such supply, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Tirunelveli and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for



a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

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5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
