ORDER

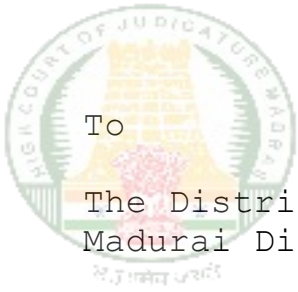
The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner sought permission of this Court to withdraw this writ petition and he has also made an endorsement to that effect.
