3.In view of the limited relief sought for by the petitioner, there shall be a direction to the second respondent to consider the representation dated 20.09.2018 made by the petitioner, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and take appropriate action in accordance with law. The second respondent before passing the orders, shall call all the parties concerned, in order to ascertain the correct facts.

4.With this direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
