PRAYER: Contempt Petition filed under section 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, to commit and punish the respondents for their willful disobedience of the order passed by this Court in W.P(MD)No.22065 of 2015 dated 10.12.2015.

Prayer in WP(MD)No.22065/2015 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the Respondents to pay all the terminal benefits payable to the petitioner including Salary arrears in terms of settlement under Section 12(3) of the Industrial Disputes Act dated 13.04.2015, Gratuity, the Commuted Value of Pension, Leave Salary with enhanced dearness allowance at the rate 107% in terms of G.O.No.245 Finance (Allowances) Department dated 10.10.2014 and dearness allowance arrears on monthly pension together with interest at the rate of 18% per annum from the date of his retirement to till the date of payment within the time that may be stipulated by this Court.
