PRAYER: Contempt Petition filed under section 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, to commit and punish the respondents for their willful disobedience of the order passed by this Court in W.P.(MD)No.21536 of 2015 dated 04.01.2016.

Prayer in WP(MD). 21536/ 2015 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court To issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to pay all the retirement benefits of the petitioner including Gratuity, the Commuted Value of Pension, Earned Leave Salary , Refund of Institute of Road Transport Contribution amount, Surrender and Encashment of Unearned Leave Salary on Private Affairs for 90 days with enhanced dearness allowance at the rate 107% in terms of G.O.(Ms) NO. 245 Finance (Allowances) Department dated 10.10.2014 together with interest at the rate of 18% per annum from the date of his retirement to till the date of settlement within time that may be stipulated by the Court, and further directing the respondents to pay interest at the rate of 18% per annum for the belated payment of provident fund and social security scheme arrears within a time limit.

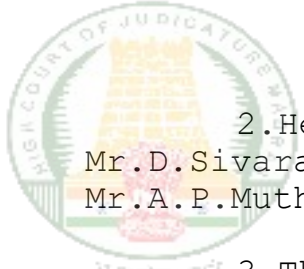
