PRAYER: Contempt Petition filed under section 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, to punish the respondents for their willful disobedience of the order passed by this Honourable Court in W.P(MD)No.21532 of 2015 dated 04.01.2016.

Prayer in WP(MD). 21532/ 2015 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to extend pay revision with an increase at the rate of 5.5% of basic pay and grade pay from 1.9.2013 to 30.4. 2014 in terms of Section 12(3) Settlement dated 13.4.2015 and to pay all the retirement benefits payable to the petitioner including Gratuity, the Commuted Value of Pension, Leave Salary with enhanced dearness allowance at the rate 100% in terms of G.O.Ms. No. 55 Transport (D) Department dated 4.6.2014 and difference in monthly pension together with interest at the rate of 18% per annum from the date of petitioner's retirement to till the date of settlement within the time that may be stipulated by this Hon'ble Court and further directing the respondents to pay interest at the rate of 18% per annum for the belated payment of the Provident Fund and Social Security Scheme arrears within the time that may be fixed by this Hon'ble Court.

The contempt petition has been filed to commit and punish the respondents for their willful disobedience of the order passed by this Court in W.P.(MD)No.21532 of 2015, dated 04.01.2016.

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2. Heard Mr.Rahul, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr.D.Sivaraman, learned counsel for the first contemnor and Mr.A.P.Muthupandian, learned counsel for the second contemnor.

3. The petitioner claims that all the terminal benefits have already been paid to the petitioner. However, balance commutation Rs.1,02,384/- + interest and leave salary of Rs.9,613/- for ten days have not been paid.

4. The learned counsel for the contemnors on instructions would submit that the amount due and payable if any shall be calculated and paid to the petitioner, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. In case of non-compliance, the petitioner can revive the contempt petition.

5. Recording the above submission, this contempt petition is closed with liberty to the petitioner to revive the contempt petition in case of non-compliance. No costs.
