Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the Respondents to settle the retirement benefits of the petitioner including Gratuity, leave salary with interest at the rate of 18% per annum from the date of his retirement to till the date of settlement within the time that may be stipulated by this Honble Court and further directing the respondents to settle the interest at the rate of 18% per annum for the belated payment of Provident Fund, the Commuted Value of Pension, Social Security Scheme arrears amount within the time.

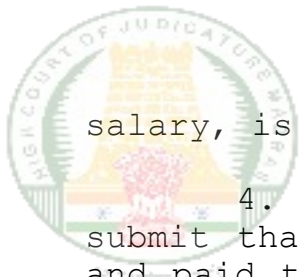
ORDER
