Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the Respondents to pay entire terminal benefits payable to the petitioner including Salary arrears in terms of settlement under Section 12(3) of the Industrial Disputes Act dt.13.04.2015, Provident Fund, Gratuity, the Commuted Value of Pension, Leave Salary together with interest at the rate of 18% per annum from the date of his retirement to till the date of payment within the time that may be stipulated by this Honble Court.
