This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.183 of 2012 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.IV, Tiruchirapalli.

2. Though the learned counsel for the petitioners raised several grounds for quashing the proceedings in C.C.No.183 of 2012, he submitted that it would suffice, if a direction is issued to the trial Court to complete the trial within a time limit that may be stipulated by this Court and also to permit the petitioners to raise all the grounds raised in this petition before the trial Court. However, he requested the appearance of the petitioners may be dispensed with before the Trial Court.

3. I have heard the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) appearing for the first respondent, who has also conceded the request of the learned counsel for the petitioners.

into the merits of the case, directs the learned Judicial Magistrate No.IV Tiruchirapalli, to complete the trial in C.C.No.183 of 2012 within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Meanwhile, the appearance of the petitioners is dispensed with unless the learned Judicial Magistrate feels that their presence is required for the disposal of the case.

5.With the above directions, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
