The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the fourth and fifth respondents made a submission that the question over the qualification and approval granted in favour of the sixth respondent is under challenge in this writ petition. However the sixth respondent attained the age of superannuation and allowed to retire from service on 31.05.2017. This being the factum, no further qualification needs to be undertaken in respect of the grounds raised in this writ petition.
