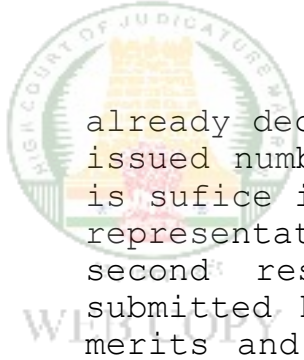

The writ petitioner claims that he is entitled for the selection grade pay in the post of Middle School Headmaster with effect from 21.06.1995 and special grade with effect from 01.06.1988 based on G.O.Ms.No.210, School Education (G-1) Department, dated

2.However, the issues in relation to the G.O.Ms.No.210 were



already decided by the Courts and the Government also, subsequently, issued number of orders in this regard. Under the circumstances, it is suffice if a direction is given to the respondents to consider the representation submitted by the writ petitioner. Accordingly, the second respondent is directed to consider the representation submitted by the writ petitioner on 10.11.2012 and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The writ petitioner is directed to enclose the copy of the representation and all the relevant Government orders along with the order passed in this writ petition.

3. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of. However, there shall be no order as to costs.
