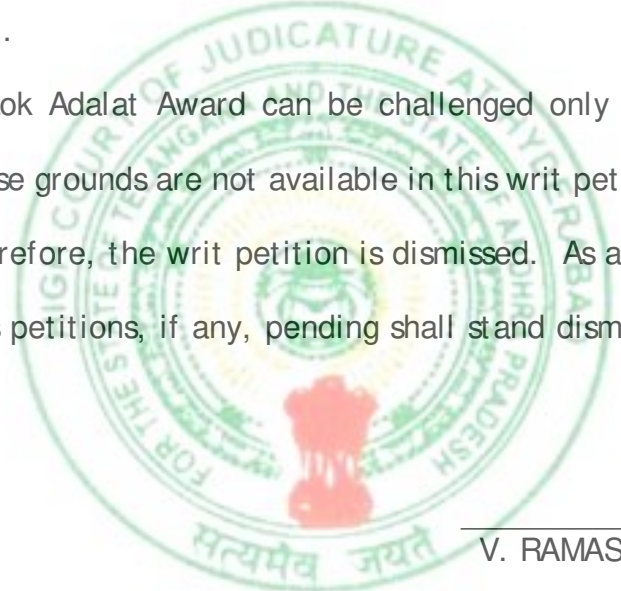
ORDER: (per V. Ramasubramanian, J)
