**ORDER:**

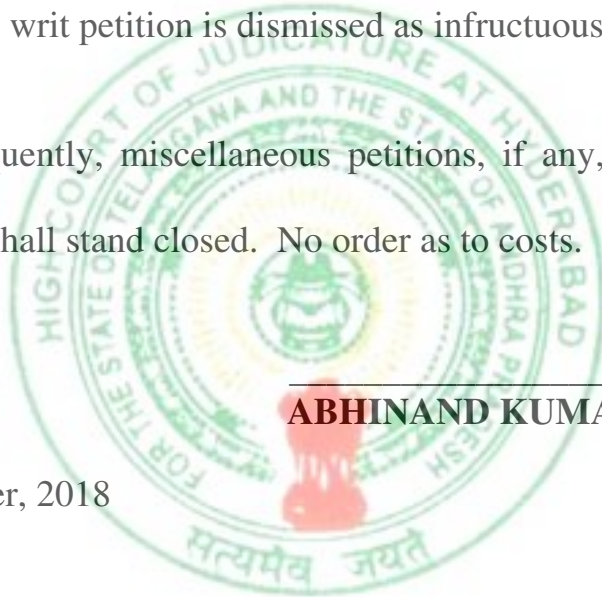
