Having heard the learned counsel for both the parties at length, we are not inclined to interfere with the order dated 19.01.2018 in I.A.No. 2 of 2018 in W.P.No. 1296 of 2018 passed by the learned Single Judge, however we direct the petitioner to release the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent 50% of the amount calculated by the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent as payable in the order dated 13.12.2017 which is impugned in the writ petition, subject to the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent furnishing bank guarantee.

With the above observation, the writ appeal is disposed of. No order as to costs.

As a sequel, Miscellaneous Petitions, if any pending, shall stand disposed of as infructuous.
