JUDGMENT: {Per the Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice Ramesh Ranganathan}

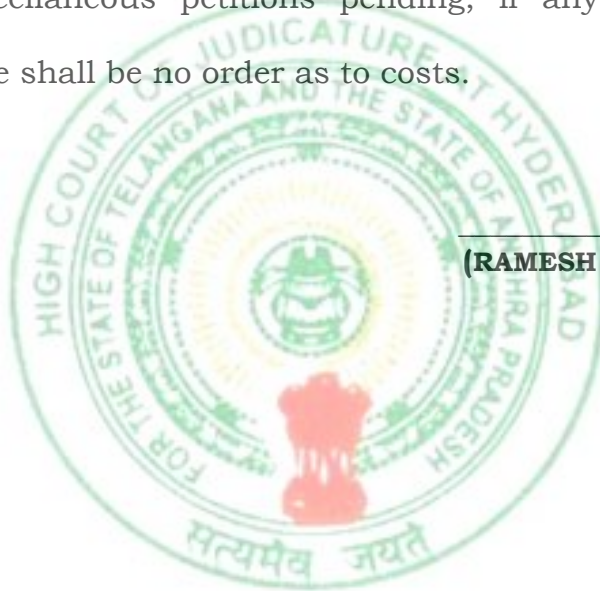
