

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE P.KESHA VA RAO

WRIT PETITION NO. 15031 OF 2015

ORDER:

Heard both sides.

The prayer sought in the Writ Petition is as under:

"...to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 4th and 5th respondents in not issuing No Objection Certificates to petitioner to start B.Ed., and D.P.Ed., colleges and for additional intake as required by 2nd respondent for submission of applications to second respondent for grant of formal recognition for the academic year 2016-2017 as arbitrary, illegal and consequently direct the 4th and 5th respondents to issue No Objection Certificates to petitioner to start B.Ed., and D.P.Ed., colleges and for additional intake as required by 2nd respondent for submission of applications to 2nd respondent for grant of formal recognition for the academic year 2016-2017."

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner informs the Court that the matter has become infructuous for the reason that the relief sought is for the academic year 2016-2017.

Taking the said submission into consideration, this Court is of the opinion that no further cause would survive in the Writ Petition.

Accordingly, the Writ Petition is dismissed.

Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall also stand dismissed. No order as to costs.
