

**HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE A.RAJASHEKER REDDY**

**WRIT PETITION No. 12225 OF 2018**

**ORDER:**

This Writ Petition is filed seeking writ of mandamus declaring the proceedings No.P1/1(44)/2015-TPT, dated 28.07.2016 issued by the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent in terminating the petitioner services on the allegation of un-authorized absence for duties as illegal and arbitrary.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri A.Rama Rao, learned Standing Counsel for respondents 1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that against the impugned proceedings dated 28.07.2016 passed by the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent, the petitioner filed mercy petition before the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent on 16.08.2017, but no orders are passed on the same.

Since the Mercy Petition alleged to be filed by the petitioner on 16.08.2017 is pending before the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent, the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent is directed to dispose of the same in accordance with the Rules within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs. As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this Writ Petition shall stand closed.
