

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE A.V.SESHA SAI

WRIT PETITION No.12558 of 2018

ORDER:

Heard the learned Counsel appearing for the petitioners, the learned Government Pleader for R.1, Sri R.Vinod Reddy, learned Counsel appearing for R.2 and R.3; and also Sri N.Praveen Kumar, learned Counsel appearing for R.4.

2. When the matter is called, it is submitted by both parties that the issue in the present writ petition is squarely covered by the common Order, dated 02.06.2017, in W.P.Nos.17501/2017 and batch of this Court. A copy of the same is filed along with writ petition as material papers. The operative portion of the said order reads as under:

“As the above interim orders itself cover the main relief of all these writ petitions, these Writ Petitions can be and accordingly disposed of with direction to the TSSPDCL Authorities to obtain undertaking affidavits and then conditionally release the power supply to the buildings of the petitioners, which is no doubt subject to compliance of all other statutory requirements by the petitioners and with the condition that in the event of refusal of grant of occupancy certificate by the concerned local Authorities viz. Panchayat or Municipality or Municipal Corporation or other Authorities as the case may be within a prescribed period, the respondents withdraw the power supply, without any need of even prior notice for such withdrawal being the conditional one.”

3. Following the said order and for the reasons stated therein, this writ petition is also disposed of in terms thereof. There shall be no order as to costs.

4. Office to enclose a copy of the common Order, dated 02.06.2017, in W.P.No.17501, 17528 and 17536 of 2017 to this order.

5. Miscellaneous Petitions pending consideration, if any, in this Writ Petition shall stand closed.
