WHEREAS the petitioner has presented under Sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, the above case through its counsel SRI K. VENKAT RAO, praying the High Court to punish the respondents/respondents herein for committing contempt of Court by willful disobedience of the orders of the Hon'ble Court dated 24-03-2015 in WP. No. 7826 of 2015 by not completing the verification process by considering and disposing of the representations dated 12-09-2014, 20-10-2014 and 09-02-2015 submitted by the petitioner and did not take appropriate action in accordance with the law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of the order passed by the Hon'ble Court;

WHEREAS the said case coming on for hearing on this day and whereas the High Court, upon perusing the affidavit filed therein and the earlier orders of the High Court dated 07-04-2017, 04-08-2017, 15-12-2017 and 26-12-2017, made the following

ORDER:-

"The learned Assistant Government Pleader for Labour, submits that meeting is being convened on 28.02.2018 for fixing the date of elections,

The learned Standing Counsel for Municipal Corporation submits that an amount of Rs.5,00,000/- has already been paid towards election expenses and voters list also has been furnished on 2.2.2018 and it is now for the Department of Labour, to take appropriate action.

If the elections are not conducted by fixing the date in the meeting to be convened on 28.02.2018, this court will have to take a serious view of the matter.
