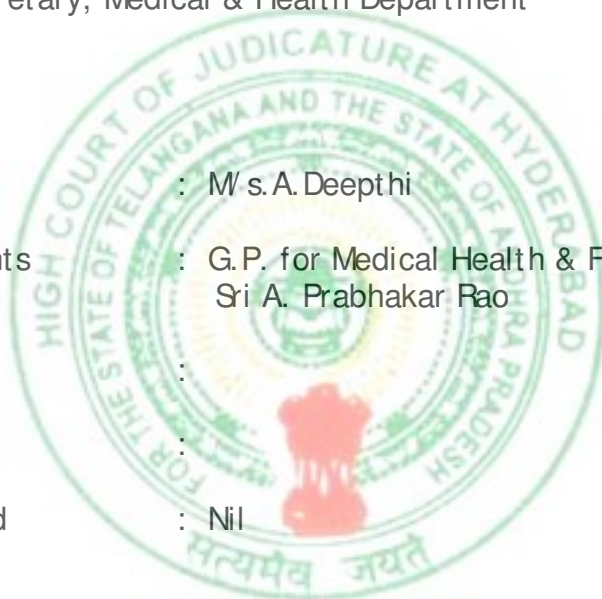

ORDER: (per V.Ramasubramanian, J.)

The petitioner has come up with the above writ petition seeking a Mandamus to direct the respondents to accept her request for correction of the online application submitted by her earlier.

2. Heard Smt.A.Deepthi, learned counsel for the petitioner. Mr. A.Prabhakar Rao, learned Standing Counsel takes notice for the 2nd respondent University.
